- Matters of truth & morality are private matters and so open discussion of such issues is an infringement on our freedom




Expressive Individualism

"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of **righteousness**, **peace and joy in the Holy Spirit**" v17



The Gospel

"For in the Gospel the **righteousness of God** is revealed, a **righteousness** that is by
faith from first to last" Romans 1:17

"This **righteousness** is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus" Romans 3: 22 - 23





Disputable matters

Adiaphora = differences which don't matter i.e. matters we can be indifferent over

- i. Food & drink v2 & 6
- ii. Sacred or Holy days v5

"I am convinced, being fully persuaded in the Lord Jesus, that nothing is unclean in itself" v14



Levels of disagreement

"Disputable matters" (Whatever you believe about these things keep between yourself and God)

Undisputed issues
